*Fugue means flight, so this is a flight from contagion, which is represented by a single 'dominant' note in the middle of the keyboard that gradually spreads upwards and downwards, in an expanding fugue subject, 'infecting' all the other notes on the piano (some more heavily/frequently than others).*
